The need for establishing an academy for imparting effective coaching for Civil Service aspirants in the state was felt in the early nineties, as the representation of Keralites into the civil service was decreased considerably. On analysis, it was understood that this was mainly due to the absence of a quality coaching institute in Kerala which catered to the needs of the civil service aspirants. With the establishment of KSCSA in Thiruvananthapuram, a long-felt need of the civil service aspirants of the state was fulfilled. KSCSA, functioning under the administrative control of the Centre for Continuing Education Kerala, was established in 2005 with the primary objective "to provide quality coaching to civil service aspirants of the state at a relatively lesser cost". Ever since its inception, there has been a steady raise in the number of students entering the portals of this academy. The exceptional coaching imparted by our excellent and experienced faculty, coupled with a well-equipped library, are the chief features which make KSCSA the most sought-after destination in Kerala for civil service aspirants. Over the years, KSCSA has carved out a niche of its own as a centre of excellence in moulding young minds to reach top positions in union civil services. Currently, KSCSA has its presence in all 14 districts, and 7 of these centres are offering the Prelims cum Mains Batch programmes.



UPSC CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION

The Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) conducts the Civil Services Examination (CSE), a nationwide competitive examination for the recruitment of candidates to various prestigious civil services of the Government of India. The examination is structured into three successive stages:

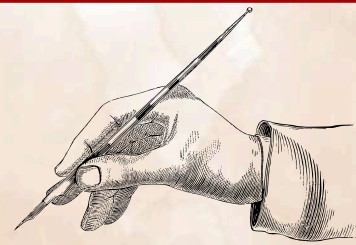
1. Preliminary Examination (Prelims)

The Preliminary Examination serves as the initial screening stage. It comprises two objective-type papers, both administered on the same day:

- Paper I- General Studies (GS): This paper carries 200 marks and evaluates candidates' general awareness and knowledge across a range of subjects, including, but not limited to, history, geography, political science, economics, and current events.
- Paper II- Civil Services Aptitude Test (CSAT): Also carrying 200 marks, this paper is qualifying in nature, requiring candidates to achieve a minimum mark of 33%. It assesses reasoning, comprehension, and quantitative aptitude skills.

It is important to note that the scores obtained in the Preliminary Examination are not considered in the final merit ranking; however, successful completion of this stage is a prerequisite for advancing to the Main Examination.





2. Main Examination (Mains)

The Main Examination is a descriptive examination conducted over a period of approximately 5–7 days. It consists of nine papers:

➤ Qualifying Papers:

- Paper A: Compulsory Indian Language (300 marks)
- Paper B: English (300 marks)

➤ Candidates are required to achieve the minimum qualifying marks in these papers, but these scores are not considered for the final merit calculation.

➤ Papers Counted for Merit:

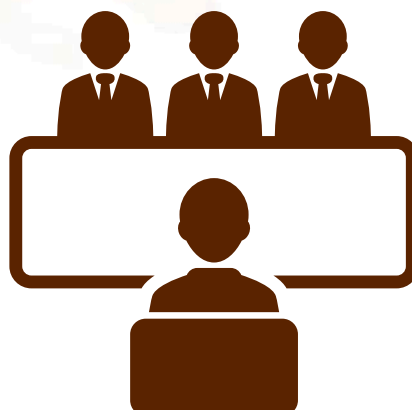
- Paper I: Essay (250 marks)
- Paper II: General Studies I (Indian Heritage and Culture, History and Geography of the World and Society) (250 marks)
- Paper III: General Studies II (Governance, Constitution, Polity, Social Justice, and International Relations) (250 marks)
- Paper IV: General Studies III (Technology, Economic Development, Biodiversity, Environment, Security and Disaster Management) (250 marks)
- Paper V: General Studies IV (Ethics, Integrity and Aptitude) (250 marks)
- Papers VI and VII: Optional Subject. Candidates are required to select one subject from the list of optional subjects prescribed by the UPSC. There are two papers for the chosen optional subject (250 marks each).

The written component of the Main Examination carries a total of 1750 marks.

3. Personality Test (Interview)

Candidates who achieve the qualifying standards in the Main Examination are invited to appear for the Personality Test, which is conducted by UPSC. This stage aims to evaluate candidates' personality traits, communication skills, mental alertness, leadership potential and overall suitability for a career in the civil services. The Personality Test carries 275 marks.

The final selection and merit ranking of candidates are determined by the cumulative scores obtained in the Main Examination (written component) and the Personality Test, with a total score of 2025.

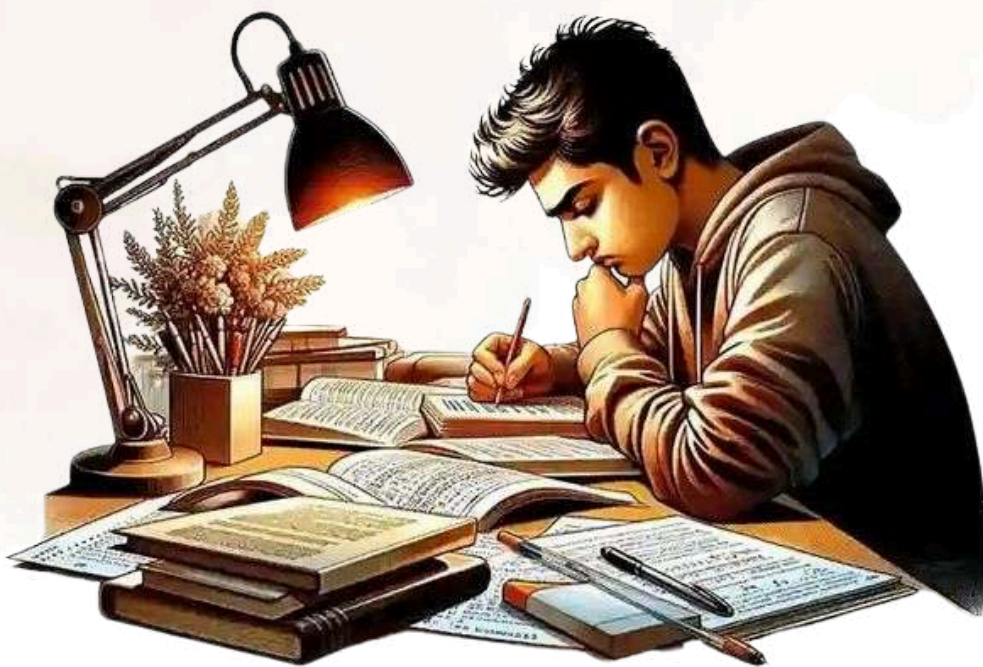

THE PRELIMS CUM MAINS BATCH AT KERALA STATE CIVIL SERVICE ACADEMY (2025-2026) OFFERS FOLLOWING FEATURES

An NCERT-Based Test Series: This series will comprise multiple tests designed to build a strong foundational understanding of the core concepts essential for the Civil Services Examination. We anticipate the inclusion of All Kerala Rank lists to enable students to assess their preparation level against their peers (Schedule : 19 July, 2025, to 27 September, 2025).

All Kerala Prelims Test Series: This comprehensive test series will cover the entire syllabus of the Preliminary Examination, incorporating various difficulty levels to provide thorough practice and evaluation. It will consist of 38 tests, including 5 CSAT tests.
Schedule: 18 October, 2025, to 16 May, 2026.

Comprehensive Study Materials: Updated and relevant study materials catering to both the Preliminary and Mains syllabi will be provided.

Regular Classes and Discussions: Engaging classroom sessions and interactive discussions on key topics are integral to the program.

Answer Writing Practice: Focused sessions on developing effective answer writing skills for the Mains examination are part of this program. These sessions will be led by faculty members who have cleared the UPSC Civil Service Mains Examination.

Current Affairs Integration: Emphasis on linking current events with the static syllabus is necessary to tackle the dynamic nature of the examination. Hence, weekly current affairs classes are part of this program.

Mentorship and Guidance: Experienced faculty will provide support and guidance to aspirants based on individual needs.



PRELIMS REHEARSE TEST SERIES

'REHEARSE' Preliminary Examination Test Series

The test series will encompass a total of 38 tests, including 5 dedicated to the Civil Services Aptitude Test (CSAT) and 3 full-length mock examinations designed to simulate the UPSC Preliminary Examination.

Schedule 18 October 2025- to 16 May 2026.

The test series will be strategically structured across three progressive levels to facilitate comprehensive preparation and performance evaluation:

1.Basic Level: These tests will focus on fundamental concepts, ensuring aspirants develop a robust understanding of the core study materials.

2.Applied Level: These tests are designed to evaluate the practical application of knowledge to dynamic and analytical questions, encouraging critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

3.Advanced Level (Full Length Tests): These comprehensive mock examinations will meticulously simulate the pattern and rigor of the actual UPSC Preliminary Examination. Notably, these advanced-level tests will include All Kerala Rank lists, providing aspirants with a valuable benchmark to assess their performance relative to their peers across the state.

RESILIENCE

The 'Resilience' Mains Examination Test Series for the PCM 2025-2026 batch will commence subsequent to the UPSC Civil Service Preliminary Examination 2026. A comprehensive schedule outlining the dates and syllabus for the Mains test series will be published separately.



OPTIONAL SUBJECTS

Classes for the Optional subjects will be held online. Currently, the academy offers following optional subjects : Political Science & International Relations, History, Sociology, Geography, Malayalam, and Public Administration.

Course Fee : ₹ 11,800 (₹ 10,000 + GST ₹ 1,800).

Class schedule: 06 August 2025 to 31 March 2026.



PCM WEEKEND BATCH 2025 - 2026

This course is primarily designed for working professionals and college students pursuing undergraduate or postgraduate degrees in Arts & Science or professional fields. Other eligible candidates, including working professionals, can also apply. This course is offered at the following sub-centres: Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Aluva, Palakkad, Ponnani (ICSR), Kozhikode, and Kalliassery. Classes are conducted on all Sundays, Second Saturdays, and Selected public holidays.

Course Fee:

Ongoing Degree/PG students: ₹41,300 (₹ 35,000 + 18% GST ₹ 6,300).

Other students: ₹49,200 (₹ 40,000 + GST ₹ 7,200 + Caution Deposit ₹ 2,000).

Class schedule: 12 July 2025 to 11 May 2026. The schedule incorporates both offline and online sessions to ensure the syllabus is completed on time.

REKINDLE- REPEATERS BATCH

CIVIL SERVICE FOUNDATION COURSE (CSFC)

This course is designed for students studying in Plus One and Plus Two classes. Foundation Course classes are held on Sundays at the academy's sub-centres in Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Pathanamthitta, Alappuzha, Ernakulam, Thrissur, Palakkad, Ponnani (ICSR), Kozhikode, Kalliassery, and Kasaragod. The curriculum includes the development of communication skills, General Knowledge, Current Affairs, awareness about the world, and basic information on civil services core subjects. Classes will commence in the 3rd month of July and conclude in the last week of March.

Course Fee: ₹ 5,900 (₹ 5,000 + GST ₹ 900)

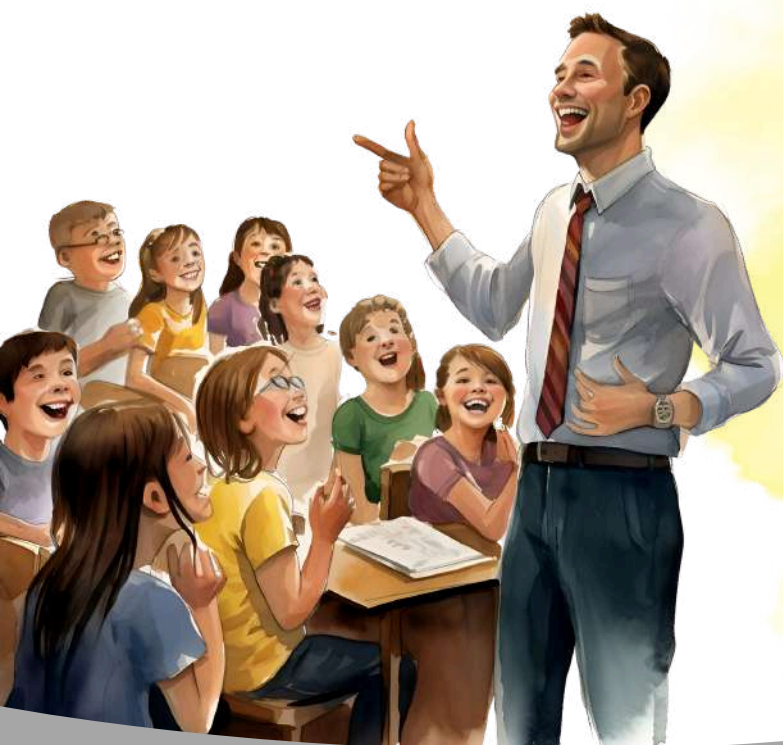
Class Schedule: 13 July 2025, to 22 February 2026 (Sundays)

TALENT DEVELOPMENT COURSE (TDC)

This course is intended for high school students (Standards VIII, IX & X), aligning with the academy's policy of "catch them young and watch them grow." The course aims to enhance young minds' communication skills, General Knowledge, mental ability and awareness of the world around them, preparing them for future competitive challenges. This course is offered at the academy's sub-centres in Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Pathanamthitta, Alappuzha, Ernakulam, Thrissur, Palakkad, Ponnani (ICSR), Kozhikode, Kalliassery, and Kasaragod. TDC classes are held once a week on Sundays.

Course Fee: ₹ 4720 (₹ 4,000 + 18% GST ₹ 720)

Class Schedule: 13 July 2025, to 22 February 2026 (Sundays)



LIBRARY & READING ROOM

Reading room facility in the Libraries of Kerala State Civil Service Academy is available to the Civil Service aspirants. Subject to the availability of reading space the facility is also extended to Non- KSCSA students.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- The **Financial Assistance Scheme by KSCSA** helps economically weaker Civil Service aspirants. This initiative reimburses tuition fees for 100 selected students annually across KSCSA centres in Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Ernakulam, Palakkad, Kozhikode, and Kalliasseri, and the Institute of Career Studies and Research, Ponnani. This ensures that financial constraints don't hinder deserving students from pursuing their Civil Service dreams.
- The **Lakshya Scholarship, by Kerala Scheduled Castes Development Department**, aids aspirants from SC/ST community. It provides financial support for UPSC coaching, covering Mains and interview expenses. Selection is through an entrance exam and interview conducted by the Institute for Civil Services Examination Training Society (ICSETS). This scheme ensures deserving students from marginalised communities can access quality Civil Service preparation.
- The **Vidhya Samunnathi Scholarship by Kerala Samunnathi** supports economically backward students from forward communities. It offers educational aid, including up to ₹30,000 for UPSC interview coaching, ₹25,000 for Mains, and ₹15,000 for Prelims. Applicants must be Kerala residents from forward communities with an annual family income below ₹4 lakhs. Apply online via the Samunnathi portal (schemes.kswcfc.org) to overcome financial barriers to quality education and career aspirations.
- The **Civil Service Fee Reimbursement (CSFR) Scheme by Kerala's Department of Minority Welfare** supports eligible minority students (Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains, Parsis) for UPSC Civil Services exam preparation. It reimburses tuition fees and may include hostel fees. Applicants must be Kerala residents with family income typically below ₹8 lakhs, enrolled in approved coaching. Applications are online via e-Grantz portal.
- The **Employability Enhancement Program (EEP) by Kerala's Backward Classes Development Department (BCDD)** aids OBC students by providing financial assistance for competitive exam coaching. Eligibility requires an annual family income typically below ₹4.5 lakhs. Applications are made via the e-Grantz portal, requiring one-time registration and document submission. This program significantly eases financial burdens, empowering OBC youth to achieve their career aspirations.
- The **Vidhyateeram Scholarship by Kerala's Fisheries Department** supports students from disadvantaged fishermen families for UPSC Civil Services exam preparation. It primarily covers coaching fees, often paid directly to centres, easing the financial burden. This scheme aims to empower meritorious students from economically weaker sections, enabling them to pursue their civil service dreams through the e-Grantz portal.
